**INFORMATION LETTER**  
**6th International Mathematical Olympiad for school students**  
**“Caucasus Mathematical Olympiad”**

The 6th Caucasus Mathematical Olympiad will take place from March 12 to March 17 2021 in Maykop, Republic of Adygea <http://cmo.adygmath.ru/>.

The Olympiad is organized by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Adygea and Caucasus Mathematical Center at Adyghe State University.

The Caucasus Mathematical Olympiad was first held in 2015 at the Sirius Educational Center (Sochi, Russia).

The Olympiad aims to create a shared cultural and educational environment for the regions of Southern Russia and countries of the Caucasus region and the Black Sea as well as to maintain friendships among students interested in Math across different countries.

The Caucasus Mathematical Olympiad includes two age leagues:

- Junior League: Grade 8-9 students in Russia and students of equivalent grades in participating countries;
- Senior League: Grade 10-11 students in Russia and students of equivalent grades in participating countries.

The Problem Selection Committee of the Olympiad includes members of Problem Selection Committees of the Russian Mathematical Olympiad, the Bulgarian Mathematical Olympiad, the Iranian Mathematical Olympiad, and the Luxembourg Mathematical Olympiad.

Due to the current epidemiological situation in the world, the Olympiad for the students outside of Russia will most likely be held online. However, if the restrictions are lifted, the Organizing Committee may adjust the rules.

The non-Russian delegations must have a regional coordinator (or a team leader) who should be responsible for:

- organizing Olympiad rounds;
- examining and coordinating works with the Jury;
- facilitating communication between the participants, the Jury and the Organizing Committee.

The participation in the Olympiad is free of charge. The tasks will be available both in Russian and English.

Our Olympiad is open for Grade 8-11 students from Southern Russia (Southern and North-Caucasus Federal Districts) and students of equivalent grades from other countries. We invite:

- the Russian Mathematical Olympiad 2019-2020 winners and award recipients among Grade 9-10 students or the Euler Olympiad 2019-2020 winners and award recipients from Southern Russia; winners and award recipients of the Russian Mathematical Olympiad 2020-2021 regional round among Grade 9-11 students or winners and award recipients of the Euler Olympiad 2020-2021 regional round from Southern Russia;
- winners and award recipients of the regional or national Mathematical Olympiads from the countries of the Caucasus region, the Black Sea region, and other countries.
